POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Oversee all aspects of RE:GENERATION for Students
 - a. Coordinate interviews with potential new leaders
 - b. Lead, encourage, equip, and empower RE:GENERATION for Students volunteers
 - c. Lead, encourage, equip, and empower the RE:GENERATION for Students directional team
 - d. Coordinate the weekly program and teach at RE:GENERATION for Students
 - e. Communicate weekly reminders via email to RE:GENERATION for Students participants
 - f. Work with Watermark Resources to distribute content and resources to other churches
2. Provide support in the planning and execution of Watermark Students summer trips
 - a. Dallas Experience (2 weeks)
 - b. Camp Barnabas
 - c. Mission of Hope
3. Produce and publish the Watermark Students Podcast
4. Availability (cell phone) after regular work hours to fulfill role duties and requirements. Watermark will reimburse a portion of cell phone expenses
5. Relationally engage and share work experience with participants in the Watermark Institute
6. Participate in general Watermark staff required activities (expense reporting, pastor on call, meetings, retreats, Christmas Eve, Easter, other "all hands on deck" events, etc.)
