- 3. Coordinate Global TRAC program to equip members with a heart for the nations and care for missionary families
 - a. Recruit and shepherd care and connect teams to maintain relationships with missionary families
 - b. Work with Global Engagement Director and Global TRAC lay leadership team to develop and execute strategy to equip, shepherd, and deploy members interested in long term missions
