- Provide support and participation in local outreach ministry events, trainings, and meetings as needed
- Provide support for lay leaders of local outreach ministries as needed
- Implement strategies to lower the barrier of entry for members to serve with local outreach ministries
- Implement a strategy to measure outcomes of local outreach ministries and a plan to identify successes worthy of recognition or celebration
- Coordinate the stewardship of the Local Outreach budget
- Communicate with the Master Calendar team regarding Local Outreach needs
- Coordinate communications support and campaigns with our internal Communications liaison
 - Collaborate to source stories for the Watermark News
 - o Implement routine maintenance of Rock data, website, and serve cards
- Coordinate a few annual, church-wide campaigns such as Love Our City, a backpack/school supply drive, etc.
- Participate in general Watermark staff-required activities (expense reporting, Staff on Call, staff meetings, retreats, Christmas Eve, Easter, other "all hands on deck" events, etc.)
