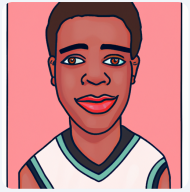

## Michael Jordan

Michael Jordan is a famous basketball player. He was born on February 17, 1963, in Brooklyn, New York, USA. When he was young, his family moved to Wilmington, North Carolina. He played basketball, baseball, and football in high school but became a star in basketball.

Jordan played college basketball at the University of North Carolina, where he was part of the 1982 NCAA Championship team. He joined the Chicago Bulls in 1984 as the third overall draft pick and quickly became a league superstar. Known for his incredible scoring and defensive skills, he earned the nicknames "Air Jordan" and "His Airness."

Jordan won six NBA championships with the Chicago Bulls, achieving two "three-peats" (1991-1993 and 1996-1998). He was also awarded five MVP titles and ten scoring titles, making him one of the greatest to ever play the game. Jordan's career scoring average of 30.1 points per game remains the highest in NBA history.

Jordan retired from basketball three times, playing briefly for the Washington Wizards before retiring for good in 2003. He later became a successful businessman, owning a majority stake in the Charlotte Hornets and co-owning 23XI Racing. He remains a legendary figure in the world of sports and beyond.

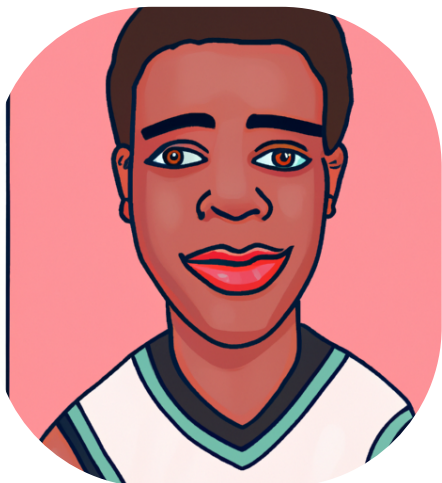
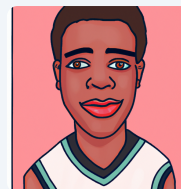
## Achievements

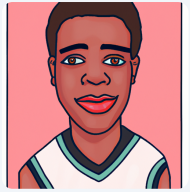
