

DIRECTIONS FOR USE SEIRIN SPINEX Intradermal Needles

en

Must be applied with care to the following patients:

- Pregnant women in whom it risks inducing labor
- Patients with malignant tumors (when it risks aggravating symptoms).
- Patients with hemorrhagic disease.

Follow the instructions below. Failure to do so may result in injury.

- 1. Spinex needles are intended for use by medical practitioners only, including doctors and acupuncturists.
- 2. Spinex needles are sterile and disposable for one time use only.
- 3. Do not use if blister packaging is damaged, discolored or if the paper seal is broken. Individualized packaging assures sterile needles.
- 4. Always check needle expiration date. Do not use expired needles.
- 5. If the treatment area becomes red or itchy, or displays other abnormal reactions, advise the patient to remove the needle and consult the acupuncture practitioner.
- 6. Caution must be taken when using needles on patients with stainless steel allergies.
- 7. Do not use for electrical stimulation, as these are not electroacupuncture needles.
- 8. Advise your patients to refrain from intense movements during insertion of the acupuncture needles.
- 9. Advise your patients that treated body parts should not be affected by strong impacts or friction.
- 10. Advise patient to remove Spinex needles before bathing.
- 11. Store needles in a safe place away from children, chemicals, humidity and extreme temperatures.
