

Move-out cleaning checklist

Doesn't time fly! Soon it's time to move out and clean this home for its next resident. The costs of failing to clean the apartment start from €329 (studio), €378 (1 bedroom), €445 (2 bedrooms), €525 (3 or more bedrooms).

Check once done:

- Vacuum the floor and skirting boards
 - Wipe the floors with a damp cloth and remove any stains. Please avoid using excessive water or soaking wet cloths.
 - Empty the cupboards and wardrobes and wipe them thoroughly from the inside and outside, including any baskets and rails
 - Remove any stains on the cupboards, walls, doors, doorways, light switches and radiators
 - Clean the windows and balcony glazing from the inside, and also from the outside from April to October. If the balcony has fixed panes at the bottom, you don't need to clean those from the outside.
 - Clean the air vents
 - Reattach the light fixture sockets
 - Empty and clean the storage spaces and balcony, if there is one
- In the bathroom:**
- Wash the tiles, grout, and the shower wall if there is one
 - Clean the floor drain
 - Clean the sink and the taps
 - Wipe inside and outside of the mirror cabinet
- Wipe all the surfaces of the toilet seat
 - Wash the sauna if there is one, including the benches, floor and door
 - Plug the washing machine connections
- In the kitchen:**
- Clean the stove
 - Clean the cooker hood and grease filter
 - Clean the oven and oven trays
 - Defrost the fridge and freezer, keeping close eye on the process. Turn off the power and dry the meltwater. Wash and dry all the surfaces and leave the doors slightly ajar.
 - Clean the dishwasher and drain filter. Turn off the tap.
 - Clean the rubbish bins
 - Wipe all the cupboards, shelves and drawers from the inside and outside, including drying racks. Remove any stains.
 - Clean the sink and tap
 - Wipe the work surfaces and splashbacks
 - Please leave all the items provided in the apartment in place, such as any sink stoppers, window keys, or curtain clips. Finally, close all the windows and doors of the apartment.
