1	Report schedule and contents	Report generation varies from merchant to merchant and depends on the speed of the report queue. Which transactions are included in the report depends on the report generation datetime.	Reports will be generated when the data is available in a spark table that is created daily between 1am and 2am Amsterdam time zone.	<p>This may cause a number of transactions to be reported twice, once in the last report of the old reporting system, and once in the first report of the new system.</p> <p>The new system itself will not report transactions multiple times (unless a second report is requested manually), nor will there be duplicates within a report.</p> <p>Potentially, transactions would be reported with a delay of up to one day compared to the old system, but with a more reliable schedule.</p>

As a result, the column names are now on row 1 and the first value is on row 2	Row 2, 3 and 4 will contain values in .xls & .xlsx files
4	Creation Date	Creation date is based on local timezone	Creation date is based on Amsterdam timezone	Creation date should be converted to local timezone before importing into downstream systems, if previous behavior needs to be replicated.
