

## Who may be involved in an investigation?

You will be involved in an investigation, as will any of your family or friends if you wish them to be. As will any other relevant people involved in your care or wellbeing or relevant to the concerns raised e.g. the police, social worker etc.

## What will happen next?

An immediate strategy meeting will be held, followed by an investigation and case conference. You will be involved in all the stages of the process.

## Will I be involved in discussions?

You will be invited to participate in the case conference. You may come alone, with a representative or send someone on your behalf. If you choose not to attend your views will be represented and you will be advised of the outcome.
