

Notice of Designation of Marple Neighbourhood Area

Decision

On 30th June 2016 Stockport Metropolitan Borough Council determined an application from Marple Civic Society which sought to establish the Marple Neighbourhood Area under the provisions of the Localism Act 2011 and in accordance with the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 as amended by the Neighbourhood Planning (General) (Amendment) Regulations 2015.

Notice is hereby given that Stockport Metropolitan Borough Council, pursuant to a decision made on 30th June 2016 by the full council, has designated the Neighbourhood Area as applied for by Marple Civic Society, as the Marple Neighbourhood Area pursuant to section 61G of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.
