1	DETERMINATION OF ADMISSION ARRANGEMENTS
	Following the consultation on admission arrangements earlier this academic year the Admission Authorities for the schools concerned (the LA in respect of Community and Voluntary Controlled Schools and the respective Governing Bodies/ Boards of Voluntary Aided schools and schools with Academy status) have determined the following matters relating to school admissions for the academic year 2022/23:
1.1	ADMISSION ARRANGEMENTS AND OVERSUBSCRIPTION CRITERIA
1.1.1	Secondary Schools – Existing admission arrangements and oversubscription criteria have been determined without change for 2022/23 for all Community, Voluntary Aided and schools with Academy status.
1.1.2	Primary Schools – Existing admission arrangements and oversubscription criteria have been determined without change for 2022/23 for all Community, Voluntary Aided, Voluntary Controlled and schools with Academy status.
1.2	ADMISSION LIMITS 2022/23
1.2.1	The admission limits of all maintained schools in Stockport have been determined as shown in Appendix 1
1.5	CO-ORDINATED PRIMARY AND SECONDARY ADMISSIONS SCHEMES
	It has been agreed that the Scheme for the Co-ordinated Admission Arrangements for all Maintained Schools in the Metropolitan Borough of Stockport Area 2022/23 be determined without change from 2021/22.
2	SCHOOL TERMS AND HOLIDAY DATES 2022/23
	The Local Authority's senior leadership has considered the feedback from consultation about school holiday and term dates. It has agreed a set of dates outlined in Appendix 2.
