

THE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL OF STOCKPORT
(FOOTPATHS 101 AND 107 HAZEL GROVE AND BRAMHALL) (TEMPORARY
CLOSURE) ORDER

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Metropolitan Borough Council of Stockport proposes to make an Order under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, the effect of which will be to temporarily close Footpaths 101 and 107 Hazel Grove and Bramhall for their complete length whilst traffic signs to that effect are in place on or near the said public footpaths.

This Order is necessary to enable works for the Poynton Relief road to take place. It is anticipated that the maximum duration of the works will be 6 months.

Alternative routes will be provided via:- From the stile at Bridle Road, north west along Footpath 3 Hazel Grove and Bramhall to Chester Rd, then along the footway north east to the start of footpath 75 Poynton-with-Worth, then south east along this footpath.

This Order is to come into operation on the 20 May 2021 and will have effect for six months, provided that if all necessary works are completed within a shorter period this Order shall cease to have effect at the end of that shorter period. Ref: ZLA/2059
