



Relationships: Our Offer

- Personal Adviser support between the ages of 16 to 25 years
- Intensive Support Worker team which offers extra support when needed, which includes evenings and weekends.
- Staying Close Project provides wrap around support to those young people in and leaving residential care, semi-independent accommodation and supported lodgings from ages 16 to 25.
- Pure Insight – local charity providing support services for care leavers aged 16- 28 years, including mentoring schemes, drop in cafes, psychological wellbeing worker and other positive activities and events
- Independent Visitor Scheme and Advocacy Support available via Coram Voice (<https://coramvoice.org.uk/advocacyservice/stockport/>)
- Personal Advisers can support you to maintain or regain contact with special people to you, such as your family, previous carers or other workers
- Previous Social Workers can remain involved with you through the Pure Insight mentoring scheme
- Designated Lifelong Links Worker and Family Group Conferencing Service to help you to repair and re-build relationships with your family and trusted adults
- Post-25 support offer
- Personal Advisers can give advice and support to you about personal safety, online safety and healthy relationships
- Personal Advisers have links with specialist services in Stockport such as the Alliance for Positive Relationships. This includes specialist support for males and females who are experiencing relationship difficulties
- LGBT support and weekly drop in
- Sex, Relationships and Education service
