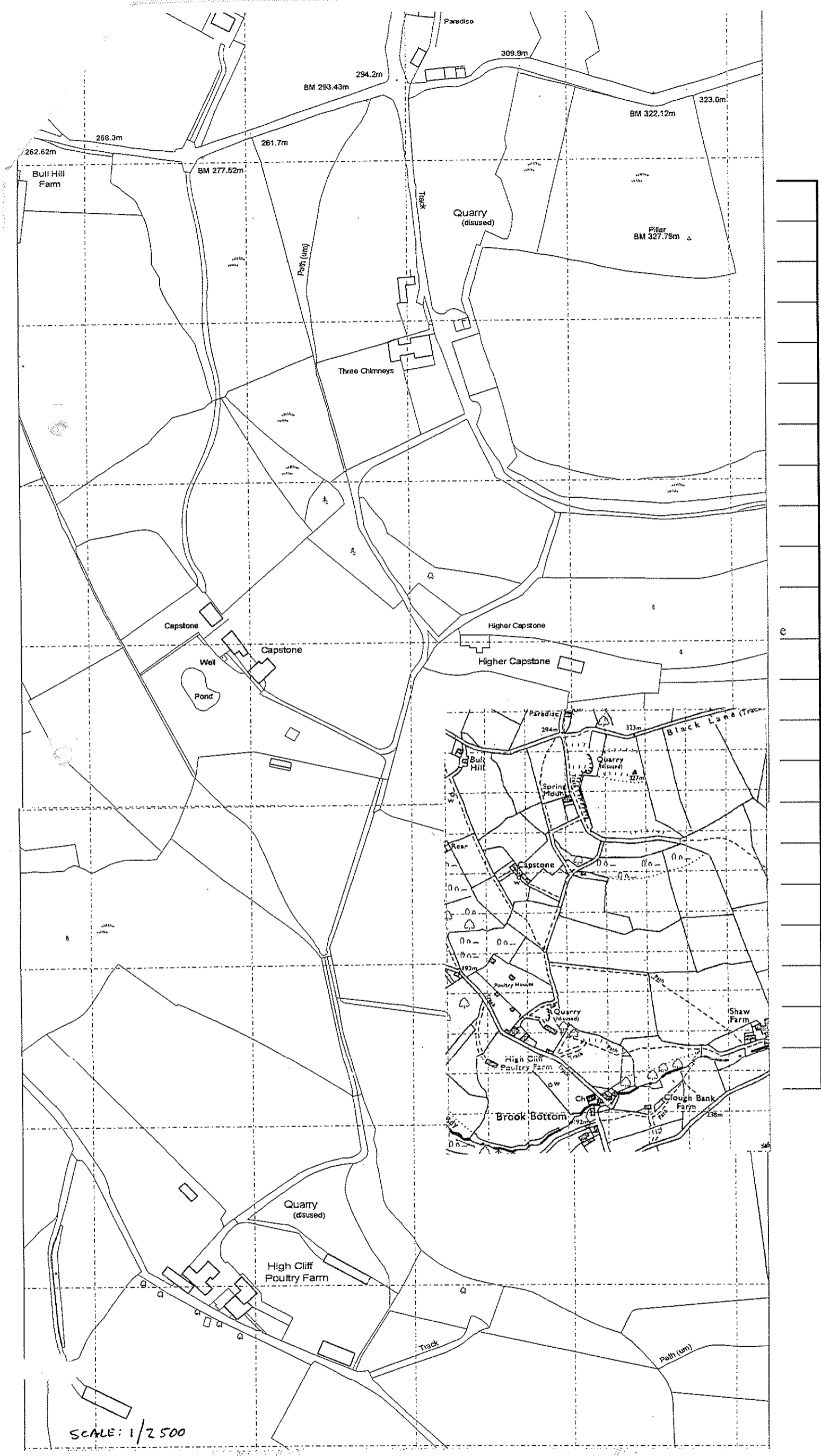

Regrading footpath to bridleway Paradise to Higher Cliff Farm

Mellor Award dated 30th July 1779

'p' refers to the page numbers of the typed copy of the Mellor Award.

The northerly end of definitive path No.141 is Catstone Stone Pit Road in the Award.

The northerly section definitive path No.144 is (or might be) Shaw Road (see page 29), and on the map is shown as leading to Catstone Gate.

Allotment 34 is the area where "Three Chmneys" now stands.

Allotment 36 is the area immediately beyond or east of path No.144 where it joins path No. 141.

p 9 " Shaw Road Number (16) one other highway or road eight yards wide at the bottom or westerly side of the Catstone stone pit Catstone Stone Pit Road Number(17). . ."

p 11 " shall be and remain public highways and must and foreever after be used and enjoyed as such . . . "

p 27 " allotment (No.35) on the easterly side therefore by the before mentioned highway or road called the Catstone Stone Pit Road No.(16) . . ."

p 29 " on northerly side thereof by the aforesaid road called Shaw Road No.(15) and on the westerly end thereof by the said last mentioned road called the Shaw Road"
