We welcome group visits all year round. To ensure that Bramall Hall can be explored comfortably, we accommodate groups of 15-60 people.

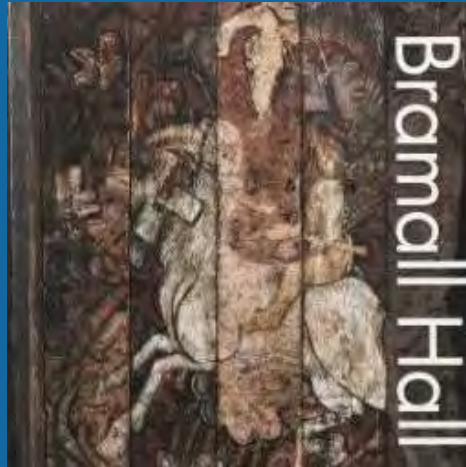
We can also arrange out-of-hours tours on request, with a minimum group size of 20 people.

Accessibility

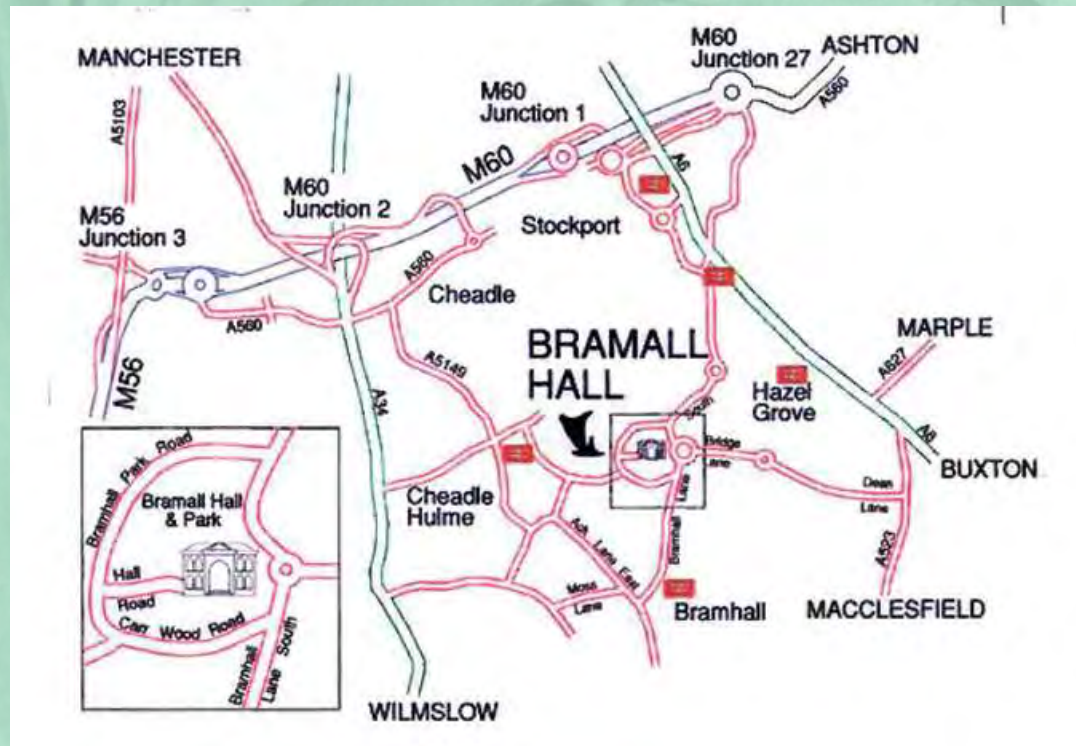
There are three disabled parking bays located in both car parks in Bramhall Park (Hall Road).

Bramall Hall is fully accessible on the ground floor. The guided tour includes viewing of the upper floors, which can only be reached by staircase. For people with limited mobility, we offer concession admission price and audio-visual information about the upper floors of The Hall.

The Visitor Centre, shop and Stables Kitchen are wheelchair accessible. Visitors should note that the courtyard entrance to these amenities contains uneven paving.

Bramhall Park contains a mixture of paved footpaths and non-paved woodland trails. There is a range of moderate and high level gradients.

How to find us



Bramall Hall is on the A5102. It can be accessed from the A34 (between Cheadle and Wilmslow) and A6 (between Hazel Grove and Stockport), both linked by the M60.

There are two pay & display car parks in Bramhall Park, within 2 minutes walk to Bramall Hall.
