ALL TRAIN Timetables changed nationwide recently on MAY 16th 2026 BUT there are also regular updates where engineering work is taking place. CHECK Rail & TRAM websites.

We give you details about your OUTWARD PUBLIC TRANSPORT journey[s] to the start of each walk.

We also advise you regarding the existence of HOMEWARD PUBLIC TRANSPORT back to Manchester or Stockport.

For the outward journey, we advise you from where to book and from where to pay for Rail transport = our 'Train via' tells you this information. However, we do not have space to give you details for the homeward journey or the 'Train via ...' information, if/when the return journey uses either a different form of Public Transport or a different rail service/rail line.

Clues such as 'Single ticket only' will give you advanced warning of this possible variation. We acknowledge that this increases the cost of travel to/from our walks but it also gives you a greater range of walk locations and adventures offered by our enthusiastic, dedicated volunteer leaders.

Please note that leaders carry-out between one and four recces in preparation for these walks, for which they pay their own transport costs on each occasion. 'Thank you' to our volunteer leaders.

Some walks use more than one rail line/service, others use 2 forms of public transport, possibly 3 forms of public transport.

REPEAT of ANNOUNCEMENT - 07/12/25 re. RAIL TICKET PAYMENTS

When buying Rail Tickets for Walkaday walks, usually book Off-Peak Day Return or Advance Singles. Those walkers aged 60 or over are advised to invest in a Senior Railcard. Make sure that you 'USE' YOUR Senior Railcard for EVERY BOOKING.

Train Ticket-types have changed, as have Refund Claims Again, DO CHECK.

OR ask at your local Railway Station.

Those who have 'Concessionary Bus Passes' are advised to pay the extra £10 p.a. to extend the 'free' use of Train and Tram travel within Greater Manchester County Boundaries – a wonderful

saving for Walkaday walkers, who are GM residents/GM Council Tax-payers. Ensure you 'USE' the card for EVERY BOOKING.

Do remember to renew this £10 payment each year! Note your OWN DATE for renewal.

BUS Timetables are changing less frequently at last and the beginning of January 2026 saw NO CHANGES this time However, there have been changes since then, the most recent being in April 2026! KEEP CHECKING!

ANOTHER THING TO KEEP CHECKING IS CHANGES to BUS STAND information at Stockport Bus Station - again, DO KEEP CHECKING in 2026.

METROLINK TRAMS - SO MANY DISRUPTIONS with ENGINEERING WORK from June to September!!

CHECK DAILY - OFTEN NO SERVICE or ONLY 'PART-SERVICE'

2. Use the main events calendar: Check the main [Stockport Council events calendar](#) and filter for events tagged with "Walkaday".
3. Download the programme: You can download the current Walkaday calendar to print at home for the latest schedule.

What to expect:

- Free walks: Walkaday walks are free to attend.
- Guided walks: These are group-led walks, with a trained leader + a backmarker.
- Variety of lengths: Walks can be circular or **linear** and vary in distance, typically 3.5-4.5 miles or less on Tuesdays & Thursdays aka T/Ts, though longer options are also available 6-9 miles on Wednesdays or Fridays aka W/Fs, which might be more challenging.
- Different starting points: Walks begin at various locations, such as village halls and bus stops and take place in up to 9 different counties across each year.
- On the Programme/Calendar, **walks in bold print are Linear walks with different starting and finishing places**, whereas ordinary print indicates Circular walks, which start and finish at the same place:

- Walkaday is organised around Public Transport, so that it is available to everyone who is fit enough to do the walks, which can be over rough ground and frequently include stiles.
- The Stockport 'Events' and 'Today' site will also give you road travel directions to the various starts but the public transport shown in the programme takes walkers to the specified starting place:
