Dear Parent/Carer, your two-year-old could have up to 15 hours of free early learning and childcare per week term time.

We know that early education is great for children. Children who take part get better at talking, making friends and are better prepared when it comes to starting school.

It's an amazing offer for parents and carers too. You could use the time to take a course, find a part-time job, or exercise in the knowledge that your child is safe and well looked after.

Who can have a 2 Year Old place?

If you live in England and get one of the following:

- Income Support
- income-based Jobseeker's Allowance (JSA)
- income-related Employment and Support Allowance (ESA)
- Universal Credit if you and your partner are on a low income from work (this usually means a combined income of less than £15,400 a year after tax)
- tax credits and you have an annual income of under £16,190 before tax
- the guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- support through part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act
- the Working Tax Credit 4-week run on (the payment you get when you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)

Or if any of the following apply to your child:

- they're looked after by a local council
- they have a current statement of special education needs (SEN) or an education, health and care (EHC) plan
- they get Disability Living Allowance
- they've left care under a special guardianship order, child arrangements order or adoption order

You can receive up to 570 hours per year completely FREE!

- No registration fee charged
- No 'conditions of access.' For example you do not have to take any additional hours
- No fees charged for free hours

When can you have a place?

Your child can start the term after their second birthday.
