DISCRETIONARY RATE RELIEF

<u>Criteria</u>

To qualify for 50% rate relief, your club has to meet the following criteria:

- Membership of the organisation must be open to all members of the community, regardless of ability, subject to the physical capacity of the premises.
- 2. Membership rates must not be such, as in the opinion of the Council, to exclude the general community.
- 3. Organisations must actively encourage membership from groups such as young people, older age groups, persons with a disability or ethnic minorities, demonstrated by either:
 - a) differential fee structures for such groups; or
 - b) provision of training schemes or education for such groups; or
 - c) a membership which consists of at least 25% of people from such groups.
- 4. The facilities of the organisation should be made available to people other than members, eg schools, casual public sessions etc., subject to licensing requirements.
- 5. Organisations must be affiliated to a local or national organisation where one exists.
- 6. More than 50% of the membership must be Stockport residents.
- 7. Organisations must provide a copy of their constitution and annual accounts when requested.
- 8. Organisations that have been granted relief must inform the Council of any change in circumstances which might affect their eligibility for relief.
