BE LISTENED TO



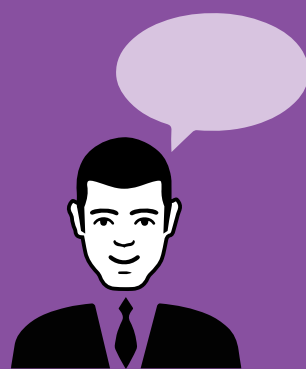
You will be heard and something will be done about any concerns you have.

PRIVACY



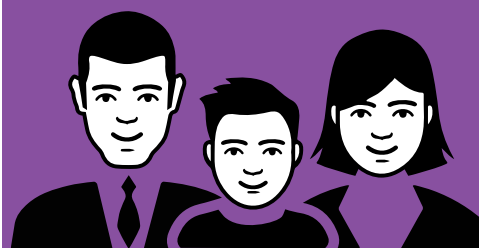
Your right to privacy will be respected.

INVOLVE YOUR FRIENDS & FAMILY



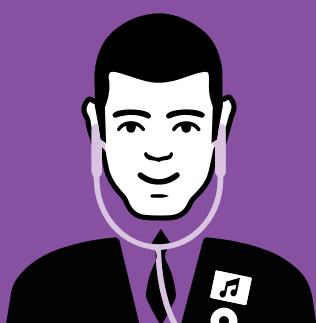
