

THE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL OF STOCKPORT
(PROW 215(A) MARPLE) (TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2018

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Metropolitan Borough Council of Stockport proposes to make an Order under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, the effect of which will be to temporarily close PROW 215(a) Marple approx. 200m length between Lock 10 and Lock 12 on the Peak Forest Canal through Marple whilst traffic signs to that effect are in place on or near the said PROW.

This Order is necessary because Construction works on behalf of Canal & River Trust, are being, or are proposed to be executed in order to repair Lock 11 on the Peak Forest Canal the lock walls have failed and are leaning inwards; consequently the lock is too narrow for boats to pass through and the Peak Forest Canal has had to be shut through Marple. Major repair works to the lock will re-build the walls and reinstate them to their original alignment.

It is anticipated that the maximum duration of the works will be 25 weeks.

Alternative routes will be provided via:- Diversion from adjacent to Lock 10, via a tarmac path through Marple Memorial Park, that emerges back onto the towpath / PROW next to Lock 12.

This Order is to come into operation on the 5 November 2018 and will have effect for six months, provided that if all necessary works are completed within a shorter period this Order shall cease to have effect at the end of that shorter period. Ref: ZA/1310
