

DETERMINATION OF ADMISSION ARRANGEMENTS
Following the consultation on admission arrangements earlier this academic year the Admission Authorities for the schools concerned (the LA in respect or Community and Voluntary Controlled Schools and the respective Governing Bodies/ Boards of Voluntary Aided schools and schools with Academy status) have determined the following matters relating to school admissions for the academic year 2023/24:
ADMISSION ARRANGEMENTS AND OVERSUBSCRIPTION CRITERIA
Secondary Schools – Existing admission arrangements and oversubscription criteria have been determined without change for 2023/24 for all Community, Voluntary Aided and schools with Academy status.
Primary Schools – Existing admission arrangements and oversubscription criteria have been determined without change for 2023/24 for all Community, Voluntary Aided, Voluntary Controlled and schools with Academy status.
CHANGE TO STOCKPORT'S CO-ORDINATED SCHEME RELATING TO APPLICATIONS RECEIVED AFTER THE CLOSING DATE
The Local Authority has considered feedback from public consultation and has determined that it will adopt the admission arrangements for the co- ordination of applications received after the closing date detailed below: An applicant who fails to submit their application before the prescribed closing date will have their application designated as being 'received after the closing date' and processed according to published oversubscription criteria. This designation as being 'received after the closing date' will remain up to and including 14 calendar days following the relevant national offer day after which point the designation will be removed resulting in a reassessment according to published oversubscription criteria.
