

Neighbourhood Forum Designation Notice

Section 61F of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as inserted by Schedule 9 Part 1 of the Localism Act (2011)) provides a local planning authority the power to designate a body or organisation as a neighbourhood forum in order to carry out neighbourhood planning in a designated neighbourhood area. Under The Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 Regulation 10, a local planning authority must publish on their website, and in such other manner as they consider is likely to bring the designation to the attention of people who live, work or carry on business in the neighbourhood area: the name of the neighbourhood forum, a copy of the written constitution of the neighbourhood forum, the name of the neighbourhood area to which the designation relates, and contact details for at least one member of the neighbourhood forum.

Woodford Neighbourhood Forum Designation

Notice is hereby given that in accordance with the Neighbourhood Planning (General)

Regulations 2012, Stockport Metropolitan Borough Council formally renewed designation of the Woodford Neighbourhood Forum as a neighbourhood forum on 18th October 2018, to undertake neighbourhood planning for the Woodford Area, the boundary of which is shown on the map attached to this document.

In accordance with the relevant regulations, the designation shall last for a period of five years from the 18th October 2018 until 17th October 2023, unless otherwise withdrawn by the Council. As a consequence of the designation, no other neighbourhood forum can be designated in the Woodford Neighbourhood Area.
