



Moving On: Our Offer

Support available:

- Personal Adviser support from 16 to 21 and up to 25 years if you want to have that support. With Pure Insight offering support up to 28 years.
- Intensive Support Worker and Staying Close workers offering extra support during evenings and weekends
- Intensive Support Worker help you to prepare for independent living, maintaining placements and support with other accommodation
- Developing a Pre-Tenancy Programme (SKILLS – Stockport’s Key to Independence, Learning and Life Skills) – to help prepare you for independent living
- Pantry scheme with 5 bases throughout Stockport to offer care leavers a free weekly shop.
- Links with Early Adulthood Team and Adult Services - Early Adulthood Social Workers attend accommodation panel to support planning, and assess care leavers with additional needs to support smooth transitions to adult services
- Multi Agency Adults at Risk Support – to identify support for vulnerable people in Stockport
- The Prevention Alliance – intensive support for care leavers living in the local community, particularly for those aged over 21 years
- Mental Health Access Team offering advice and support through consultations with the Leaving Care Team
- Psychological Wellbeing Workers from Pure Insight offering support to help care leavers access mental health and counselling services up to the age of 28 yrs.
- Stockport Homes services including resettlement workers, money and debt advice support and counselling
- Pure Insight mentor scheme and positive activities for care leavers up to the age of 28 yrs.
- Free gym passes – including a “plus one” so you can register a friend and go together Up to the age of 25 yrs.
