The amount charged depends on the Government's banding of your property which is determined by the property's value. This is shown on your bill.



## 5 Adult Social Care Precept

The cost of adult care is increasing due to inflationary costs and increasing demand on services which support our elderly and vulnerable residents. As a provider of adult social care services Stockport Council is allowed, by Central Government, to include an Adult Social Care Precept on Council Tax Bills. For 2025/26 this Precept will increase by 2% raising additional income to support the funding of the increasing costs of providing adult social care services.
