- Retired Retired members and survivors receiving a monthly pension
- Deferred Members who left their OMERS employer but kept their pension in the OMERS Plan
- Disability Waiver Members with an injury or illness who continue to earn credited service
- **Divested** Members divested from an OMERS employer to another non-OMERS employer that has a registered pension plan

Please note that the information shown in the tables is based on data submitted to OMERS by employers. Employers are provided with a summary of their employees' affiliations on an annual basis. The affiliation of each member is also reported in the member's annual Pension Report. At any time, the employer and the member (via the employer) can update an employee's affiliation.

The information presented is not used for pension administration purposes. The information should not be relied upon for any other purpose than to provide a general indication of the distribution of OMERS membership by employee affiliations.


