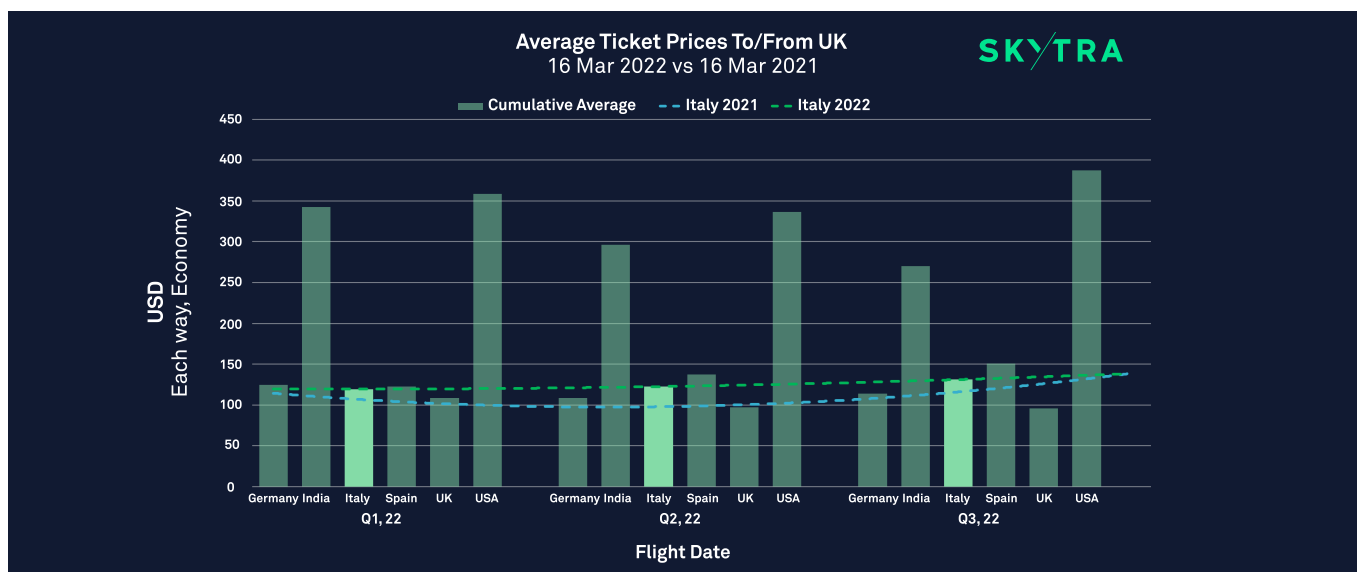


## UK Travel data

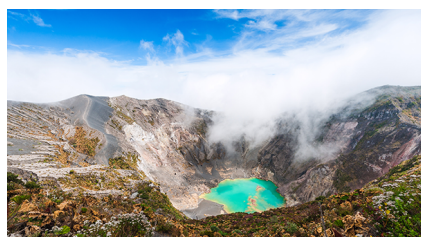


- Travel between the UK and popular European destinations such as Germany, Spain and Italy is generally 10-15% higher than for the same period in 2021, although tourists will pay an average of 25% more than last year to travel to Italy in Q2 (April/May/June).

## Other travel highlights

- When looking at UK-USA, Q2 is currently where the data shows the cheapest average ticket prices: \$338 each way vs \$387 for travel in Q3 (July/August/September).
- There has been a considerable month-over-month improvement in passenger travel between the UK and APAC, now at 61% of pre-pandemic levels vs only 46% in mid-Feb. Travel restrictions in the region are gradually starting to ease; Australia, one of the top long-haul destinations for British travellers, finally re-opened its borders to all fully vaccinated visa holders on 21st Feb.
- Passenger traffic to/from Europe (67% of 2019 levels) and North America (58%) are also showing steady signs of improvement, as business travel resumes.

When looking at all tickets issued in the four weeks leading up to 16th March, Skytra data shows that travel between the UK and Latin America – which includes popular leisure travel destinations in the Caribbean – is performing particularly well.

Revenue passenger kilometres (RPK), a metric that captures the combined distance flown by all paying passengers, currently stands at ~90% of 2019 levels.
