Below we inform about the collection of personal data for the procedure of sending dunning letters. Personal data is all data that relates to you personally (for example: name, address, e-mail addresses, phone number etc.).

1. Contact Details and Company Data Protection Officer

2. Purposes of Data Processing and Legal Bases

(1) The data will be collected, stored and, if necessary, passed on as far as necessary in order to be able to claim the owed debtor's performance by the creditor. If the debt is due, the debtor comes through the unsuccessful reminder in debt default. The collection, storage and dissemination are therefore carried out for the purpose of pre-contractual measures at the request of the data subject on the basis of Article 6 paragraph 1 sentence 1 letter b GDPR. Failure to provide this information may result that it can lead to the fact that outstanding claims can not be collected.

We transfer personal data, if necessary, only to responsible employees, courts, lawyers, banks or debt collection offices.

Further processing only takes place if you have given your agreement or if you have a legal permit.

(2) We maintain current technical measures to ensure the protection of personal data. These are adapted to the current state of the art.

3. Duration of Data Storage

As far as we do not process your contact data for operational purposes, we store the data collected for the dunning letters until expiry of the statutory or potential contractual warranty and guarantee rights. For this period the data will be used solely for the case of a business partnership development review. After this period, the data collected for the application will be deleted (1 year after conclusion of contract) or blocked if deletion is not possible.

4. Your Privacy Rights

You have the right to request information from us at any time about your personal data stored with us (Article 15 GDPR). This also applies to the recipients or categories of recipients to whom this data is shared and the purpose of the storage. In addition, you have the right to demand, under the conditions of Article 16 GDPR, the correction and / or, under the conditions of Article 17 GDPR, the cancellation and / or, under the conditions of Article 18 GDPR, the restriction of processing. Furthermore, under the conditions of Article 20 GDPR, you can request data transfer at any time - provided the data is still stored by us.

In the case of processing of personal data for the purpose of performing public interest tasks (Article 6 paragraph 1 sentence 1 (e) GDPR) or legitimate interests (Article 6 paragraph 1 sentence 1 (f) GDPR), you may refuse processing personal data concerning you at any time, with future effect. In the event of an objection, we shall refrain from any further processing of your data for the aforementioned purposes,

- unless there are compelling, legitimate grounds for processing that outweigh your interests, rights and freedoms, or
- unless the processing is necessary for the assertion, exercise or defense of legal claims.

Under the conditions laid down in Article 21 paragraph 1 GDPR, data processing may be objected to for reasons arising from the particular situation of the person concerned.
