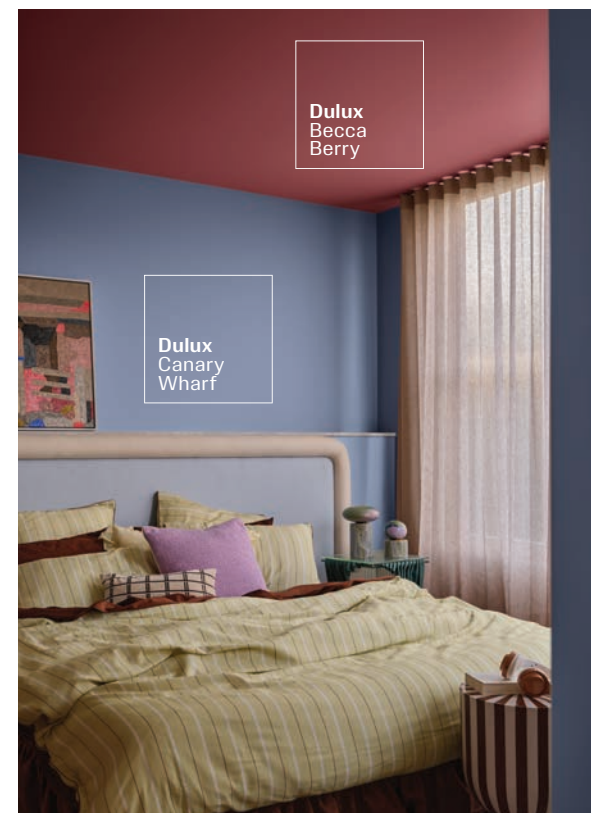
Sensory

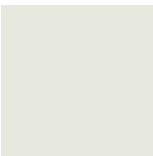
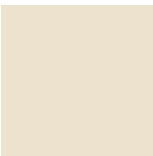
