Elegant and refined, the harmonious lines and movement of waves influences colour and pattern in our interiors.

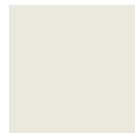

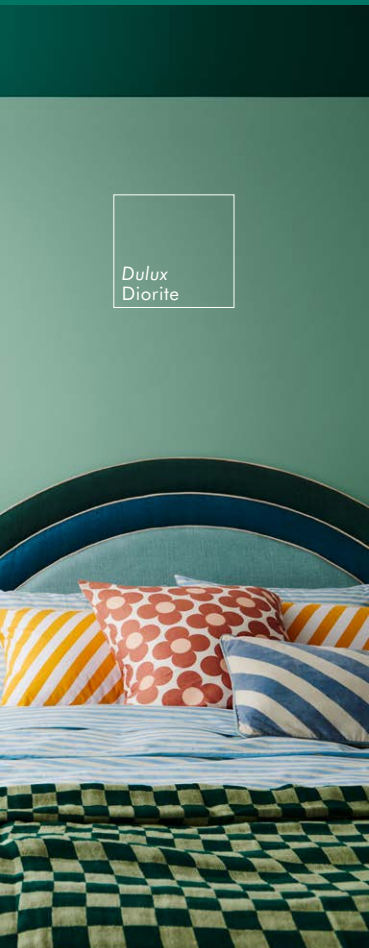

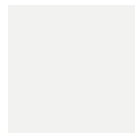

We look for sustainability, authenticity and meaning in the items we choose to connect with in our homes.

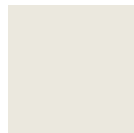
