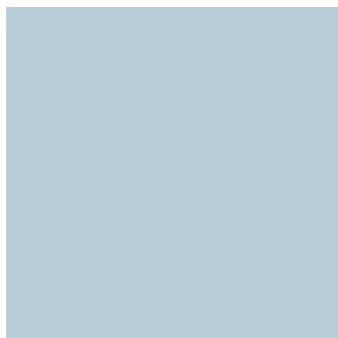
Seeing Green

Feature green in your home to create areas of calm. Deep tones of green can create a dramatic backdrop for your room, while pastel tones can offer a relaxed and serene palette to help create

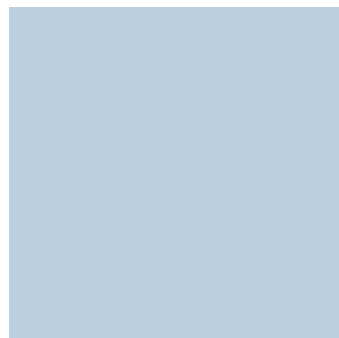
