

Advice to Government Review of the Gambling Act 2005

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Annex J - Bibliography

As part of its role, the Gambling Commission ('the Commission') provides formal statutory advice to the Secretary of State under Section 26 of the Gambling Act 2005 ('the Act').

From December 2020 to March 2021, the Department for Digital, Culture, Media and Sport (DCMS) conducted a <u>Call for Evidence on the effectiveness of the Gambling Act 2005</u>, the Act which sets out how gambling in Great Britain is regulated. The Secretary of State has asked the Commission to provide advice on Government policy and legislation in relation to gambling and specifically on each of the topics of the Review. The <u>Commission's statutory advice to Government is set out on our website</u>.

This annex provides a bibliography of evidence used to inform the Commission's statutory advice. This bibliography includes links to academic research, external organisations and other sources of evidence. The links were current at the point of publication, but the Commission will not be updating links to this evidence over time.

The Commission also considered <u>advice provided to us by our three advisory groups</u> - Advisory Board for Safer Gambling (ABSG), Lived Experience Advisory Panel (LEAP) and Digital Advisory Panel (DAP).
