Response

In the attached spreadsheet is a list of all operators that have applied for a remote operating licences since May 2014 following on from the changes to the licensing requirements for remote operators offering facilities for gambling to consumers in Great Britain. A total of 575 licence activities have been applied for, by 333 operators. The information is broken down by the activity each operator has applied for.

In specific response to your second request, using the spreadsheet attached the operators which have received full licences are those with a case status of determined in column C, this relates to 206 individual operators.

For those operators which have received full licences in place of transitional licences, these can be found by filtering column F to show 'Transitional Replacement' only. There are 77 individual operators that have received full licences in place of transitional.

The operators that have applications pending are those with a case status of 'pending' in column C, there are 36 operators with applications pending.

All operators with case status of determined or interim now have an active licence in relation to the licence activity detailed in column E. A total of 517 licence activities are active by 292 operators

The Commission has refused 1 licence application, relating to 1 activity.

Of the 333 applications received from operators 13 operators have withdrawn their application. These can be identified by filtering column C for 'withdrawn'.
