

# The **art** of **illumination**




The way you light your bath space is based on the usage and mood you would like to form.

Do it right with ambient, task, and night to create the perfect bathroom scheme. Task lighting augments your grooming space through large modular lights or discreet built-in lighting found in cabinets and vanities. Not only does this lighting ease the task of getting ready, but also adds flair to your bathroom.



Ambient lighting, through lighted mirrors, provides overall illumination with a soft glow that envelops the space and allows safe navigation through your bathroom. Vanities and mirrors with inbuilt backlights enhance visibility and illuminate the general space at night with low, diffused light that is soft on the eyes.





The solid, vertical structure that is built to protect and divide, can be the single most important feature for a washroom. It's all about how you accentuate this surface by bringing in a little boldness and personal style.






Incorporate an ample amount of texture, color, and pattern to create a bold visual impact and still find tranquillity with the negative white space. Team up a blue-andwhite-tiled highlighter wall with neutrality of grey for the rest of the space.

Warm beige walls create an open and inviting space, as the color has a relaxing effect that allows fittings and accessories to stand out. Natural light also plays its role in breaking the monotony of the color palette, adding to the cheerfulness of the room.

### Calming Aura of **Wabi Sabi**




Elevate your bath space with the Japanese philosophy of impermanence and incompleteness. The Wabi-Sabi effect celebrates the imperfect, impermanent and incomplete. 'Wabi' stands for understated elegance in Japanese, while 'Sabi' represents enjoying the imperfections.





Tie the bath space together to create a calming ambiance with a concrete countertop, black-andwhite patterned tiles, wood, black metal, a whole lot of greens, and natural sunlight. For a truly impactful Wabi-Sabi effect, always strive to keep the bath space area light and uncluttered, and remember that less is more.

### **Essentially Forest**



Taking inspiration from the environment can help to consciously craft a bath space, for example using hues associated with tropical rainforest. The aesthetic will reflect a biophilic indoor space by rejuvenating the inhabitants with a metaphorical visual connect with nature, through various creative interpretations.







Even the powder room, one of the most used bathrooms in any home and probably the only one guests may visit, can be thoughtfully conceived. It can for one be inspired by a little cave of fuchsia, with a black and white chevron floor that tends to transcend one into another parallel world temporarily whilst upholding boldness and contrast.

### Sea your space



Windows, glass doors, and skylights let sunlight brighten the room, so allow light to illuminate your space by using simple translucent window treatments. If natural light is limited, consider mounting a mirror opposite a window or creating a faux skylight to make the space feel larger and brighter.

Mixing modern, vintage or rustic fittings with robust textures and a neutral palette allows flexibility whilst textured whitewashed surfaces are also a great way to bring in a coastal look.

If you choose to accent your space with color, splash it rather than saturating it. Incorporating blue tones is a great way to capture the serenity of water and sky. Accentuating your bathroom wall with some sea-toned serene wallpaper is also a good idea. The pattern, texture, and splash of color will transform a neutral canvas into a realm of tranquillity.

My favorite work of architecture is the Church of the Light by the Japanese architect Tadao Ando. The reinforced concrete chapel, located in Ibaraki, Osaka, Japan has inspired and influenced my own architectural design sensibility. I love the way Ando has used the concrete surface as a canvas on which his adroit manipulation of natural light creates a contemplative environment that varies throughout the day.

This use of natural light on concrete surfaces is a motif used through Ando's projects, and The Church of the Light is particularly striking in that it represents the perfect balance between mass, volume, and levity: the offset intersection of four concrete panels at the altar forms a cross of natural light which in itself is a structural marvel, embodying a delicate equilibrium between solid and void.

The Church of the Light for me has been an inspiration as it is a powerful and compelling statement of minimalist aesthetic as a catalyst for deep reflection, worship, and meaning. I would someday love to sit in the pews and reflect both 'within' and 'without'.
