



AIRPORT OVERLOOK

FACT SHEET

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The Airport Overlook was moved for the North End-Around Taxiway project and future fourth parallel runway. The 600,000-square-foot area includes the spectacular airfield, skyline and terminal views enthusiasts have enjoyed for decades. It features modern amenities, paved parking and an expanded food truck staging area.

AMENITIES:

Views of multiple runways, the Charlotte skyline, paved parking, LED lighting, shaded areas, bathrooms, two age-specific playgrounds, an expanded food truck staging area with picnic tables and signage displaying Carolinas aviation history.

NUMBER OF PARKING SPACES:

145 (six handicapped accessible)

NOTABLE INFORMATION:

- This is CLT's fifth Overlook location since the Airport opened in 1937.
- The tail sign to be installed at the Overlook entrance was formerly located on Josh Birmingham Parkway before it was removed in 2014.
- The Overlook site also includes a USAir Flight 1016 memorial.
