# Reminder of Slate of Recommendations being Analyzed

1. Utilize Altitude-based Turns
2. Utilize Divergent Departure Headings
- 3. Modify Use of Departure Profiles - *June***
4. Utilize Alternating Arrival Rails
5. On South Departures, delay Turns off 18L (East) and 18C (West)
6. On South Departures, change heading at first turns off 18L (East) and 18C (West)
7. Remove the 2-mile Restriction on Departures
- 8. Utilize CDA (Continuous Descent Approach)**
