Name	Gravestone text / Narrator VO	Environmental / quest ideas
Dolag "The Tosser" Duff	"'Champion tosser of Talunfern. Old Duffy tossed himself into the history books and an early grave.' <i>A fresher etching below reads, 'Of cabers, you grub.'</i> "	Character barks to the effect of "Champion tosser? Well, well." / "Consider me thrown." etc. when interacted with.
Sedric Burrowe	"Went down the pits. Found in bits."	Player can take and use the shovel sticking out of the grave mound.
Agate Breame	"Now laid to rest / It was for the best / As folk will tell / She'd started to smell."	Flies buzz around the grave mound.
Letitia Greedy	"I told you they were organised."	Chicken feathers strewn across the grave mound.
Rhodendra Bloome	"Couldn't have brought flowers, eh? Make it peonies. Nice ones. Not cheap posies from that baggage in Fenwood."	Gives temporary buff if correct flowers are 'given' to gravestone.
Molan Small	"A man walked into a bar. And it knocked his block off."	Two beer bottles sit next to each other by the gravestone.
Finneas Serpyns	"Turned his coat, so they opened his throat."	A dagger can be dug up from the grave mound.
Barneigh Silt	"'Sink or swim,' they said. 'No, not literally,' they said. 'Barneigh, the boat—!' they said."	Squelchy/wet sound effects when grave mound is walked on.
Farleigh Pousan	"Spatchcocked. Not in a good way."	Sarcastic party member bark: "Ha. Sounds like he got a good grilling."
Perpetua Sanguis	"Fell foul to a fair, fanged fop. Fiddlesticks."	A bulb of garlic sits on the gravestone.

## Sombre / quest-related

Name	Gravestone text / Narrator VO	Environmental / quest ideas
Silvermonks Robbie	"After four-and-ten years in twain / At rest now companions again."	Two gravestones sit together: one large and one small, with a bone and collar lying on its mound.
Taenya Carle	"Here lies an empty grave. A tribute to Taenya's light, which never returned from the forest's night."	If dug up, this 'empty' grave reveals the body of a man hurriedly buried. Player character will remark on him definitely not being its intended occupant. Begins/progresses a murder investigation side-quest.
Vareth Duonne	"'May death suffer for what breathed life a pair it now severs. Await me, brother, that we may rest as one.' <i>Graffiti on the tomb reads, 'Murderer.'</i> "	The red graffiti is visible on the gravestone asset.

Ilsevel of Rugge	“Her bravery belied her station. Let her spirit dash the cliffs and swell the seas in the Ocean Master’s embrace.”	Taking the small shell trinket draped over the tombstone will nerf the player character with water-based effects as long as it remains (cursed) in their inventory.
Briállen, forsaken of Mōna	“Stay your hand, friend, lest it disturb the nightshade stake that binds young Briállen aground. May the Moon Master’s gaze rest upon her kith and kin.”	Digging up this grave results in the awakening of Briállen - a bánánach (battlefield spectre). Player character must either agree to help resolve her curse or kill her for good.
Mairsil, Cassair, and young babe Maotháin	“Lost to a bánánach of the bleeding fields. Beware the war’s haunt or forever forsake Fodhla’s silver plains.”	Provides additional information about the cursed ‘bleeding grounds’ nearby. Updates knowledge for a main story quest and Briállen’s side-quest (if applicable).
Daghán Ó Chonaire	“A true and gruesome end / For one who did forfend / The Chonaire clan with might / But, alas, fair spoil’d the fight.”	Flavour storytelling re. the nearby Chonaire estate ruins: party members can remark, “Spoil’d the fight? So, what, he got everyone killed?”
<i>Unnamed</i>	“The name of the one who rots here was unworthy of the stone upon which we etch these words. May Olessa’s deeps one day swallow his grave, bones and blood all.”	Digging up the body will reveal a skeleton whose head is separated from its neck.
<i>The name of this grave’s occupant has been scorched from the stone.</i>	“By daily proof you shall me find / To be your one, in heart and mind.”	The gravestone is falcon-shaped - a clue pointing to the great Gale-Tamer, Faucon. Digging the grave yields a totem that imbues the player with a boon from Euae the Blood Master and offers a clue to Faucon’s location.
Hellen Flayme	“Resurgam.”	A small bundle of white, purple, and yellow flowers lies on the grave.
