#### What is Dental cover?

# Making the cost of essential dental treatment more affordable

Dental cover offers reimbursement towards the cost of routine, minor and major dental care such as check-ups, hygienist visits, fillings, crowns and even dental implants (not available on all policies).

You can also add family members to the policy for an additional cost, and receive cover towards child orthodontic fees – regardless of their treatment need grade.





## Why Dental cover?

Looking after your teeth and visiting the dentist regularly is an important part of maintaining a healthy lifestyle.

But finding an NHS dentist is increasingly tricky. Moreover, NHS dental charges are reviewed regularly — in England they have increased cumulatively by 12.5% in the past 2 years alone.\* An examination on the NHS can cost £26.80 (Band 1\*\*) with some major treatment such as crowns and bridges costing over £300

As a result of private dental treatment prices varying from practice to practice and the struggles finding an NHS dental care, many people worry about accessing affordable dental treatment for themselves and their families.


