The technology powering Aura is unique - Cognitive Systems owns the entire IP stack, from the custom designed silicon chipset that enables the real-time collection and processing of radio-frequency (RF) data, to the patented algorithms layered onto the chip that are used to detect and identify WiFi disturbances caused by movement, to the artificial intelligence and machine learning technology that allows Aura to continually learn about your home.

Aura also offers <u>IFTTT</u> integration so users can connect the system with other smart home products, creating a customized smart home experience.

Aura is managed using the free smartphone app available from the Apple App Store and on Google Play. The app provides users with an easy way to view live motion, motion history, activity updates of known members, and includes controls that allow users to set up to 5 different scenes.
