
EXHIBITOR MAP

1. STOP AT EVERY BOOTH

2. ASK LOTS OF QUESTIONS

What different careers are represented at this workplace? I'm interested in _____. Would there be any roles related to that here? What experience would I need to work here? What does your day-to-day job look like? What things should I consider when picking ___ as a career? What advice would you give someone who is interested in this field? What steps did you take to get where you are? What opportunities outside of school helped prepare you? What soft skills (problem solving, teamwork, communication, etc.) do you look for most in employees?

3. KEEP THE CONVERSATION GOING

Reflect on this event; what stood out to you? Did you learn anything new? Do you feel more or less confident about your future? Continue to ask questions and learn about the options out there. Remember that career exploration is a journey, you don't need to have it all figured out. You're allowed to change your mind and path along the way.
