Find of the Day: Brown Cup *Rutstroemia firma* on a fallen oak twig. It is probably not really rare, but small and hidden in fallen leaves, so easily missed.

Crepidotus sp	An Oysterling	A small white one
Daldinea concentrica	King Alfred's Cakes	Black lumps on fallen ash
Datronia mollis	Common Mazegill	Bracket with maze-like pores
Diatrypella verrucaeformis	Hazel Barkspot	black discs on fallen hazel branch
Fomes fomentarius	Hoof Fungus	High up on an ash stump, hoof-shaped.
Ganoderma australe	Southern Bracket	On upright ash
Hymenochaete rubiginosa	Oak Curtain Crust	on fallen oak log
Hypholoma fasciculare	Sulphur Tuft	in clusters on dead wood and roots
Hypoxylon fuscum	Hazel Woodwart	Warts on dead fallen hazel branches
Kretschmaria deusta	Brittle Cinder	Greyish crusty fungus on dead stump
Lycoperdon pyriforme	Stump Puffball	on dead roots and stumps
Mycena galericulata	Common Bonnet	A small slender brown mushroom on fallen log
Mycena inclinata	Clustered Bonnet	In clumps on fallen log
Phyllactinia guttata	Hazel Mildew	On underside of attached hazel leaves
Pluteus salicinus	Willow Shield	Greyish-capped mushroom on a fallen decayed log, oak or ash
Pluteus umbrosus	Velvet Shield	Inside a rotting ash stump
Postia tephroleuca	Grayling Bracket	Wet spongy bracket on dead stump
Rhytisma acerinum	Tar Spot	Black spots on attached sycamore leaves
Rutstroemia firma	Brown Cup	on a dead oak twig
Septoria cornicola	Dogwood Spot	Purple spots on attached dogwood leaves
Steccherinum ochraceum	Ochreous Bracket	Spiny spore surface
Stereum gausapatum	Bleeding Oak Crust	small bracket on fallen oak branch, bleeds red where damaged
Stereum hirsutum	Hairy Curtain Crust	Small bracket on fallen branches
Stereum subtomentosum	Yellowing Curtaincrust	Thin bracket, stains yellow where damaged
Trametes gibbosa	Lumpy Bracket	Thick white bracket on fallen log
Trametes versicolor	Turkeytail	Small zoned bracket on dead fallen branch
Trochila ilicina	Holly Speckle	black spots on fallen holly leaves
Xerula radicata	Rooting Shank	On bare soil in woodland
Xylaria hypoxylon	Candlesnuff	on old dead black decayed wood
