




FIELD LOG DASHBOARDS


FIELD LOG DASHBOARDS



Why not just get reports from the accounting system?

LAG TIME

Daily information is the key to adjusting immediately in the field. Accounting systems typically lag a week or even several weeks behind actual production. By then, it may be too late to correct problems or impact project success.
