Goals

Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) needed a way to generate a multi-year pavement management plan based on financial facts and engineering data. Ideally, the plan needed to be roadway-specific, budget-constrained, and capable of being used to assess the impact of allocated funding.

TxDOT defined the following goals:

- 1. Develop a comprehensive, uniform 4-year pavement management plan
- 2. Generate pavement projects based on roadway-specific data and fiscal constraints
- 3. Predict project outcomes and assess the impact of allocated funds



Challenges

TxDOT manages 80,444 centerline miles of roadway and inspects 54,180 bridges located in its 25 highway districts. The state sees 197.4 billion annual vehicle miles traveled (VMT) on state-owned highways—making it not only the largest, but also one of the most heavily traveled networks in the United States.*

Maintaining statewide transportation assets and providing a high-quality road system are vital for the state's economy and public safety. To contain the costs of managing its road network, TxDOT applies innovative asset lifecycle management strategies to preserve and restore the condition of roadway assets.

Texas legislation requires that TxDOT annually provide the state's Legislative Budget Board and the Governor with a detailed plan for the use of transportation funds. Among other things, the plan must include pavement condition targets and a district-by-district analysis of how proposed maintenance spending will impact pavement scores.
