Lexis Al+ with Protege: An advanced legal AI assistant specifically designed for tasks like legal research, document analysis, and brief drafting.

We are already seeing the incredible value these tools bring to our practice. For instance, some of our legal teams are using NotebookLM to manage discovery reviews. By uploading depositions, contracts, and other evidence, the team can quickly query the entire document set, uncover connections, and build a comprehensive case timeline.

We've implemented a highly efficient workflow using Lexis AI+. Our talented paralegals now upload all court pleadings for a new matter into the system. The AI generates a detailed report, including a summary of arguments, key legal citations, and potential weaknesses. This report is then provided to the assigned attorney, giving them a significant head start on developing a strategic response.

Courts in the Community



A pending case in El Paso County District Court is attracting Denver-area media attention because its ruling could set a precedent for HOA accountability in Colorado. Homes.com and **The Denver Post recently interviewed Robert Schifferdecker**, who is representing 21 of the 150 homeowners in the Soaring Eagles Townhomes HOA case. A \$21,000 surprise bill sent to each home sparked the dispute. The HOA issued the special assessment to pay for a \$3 million insurance deductible for roof repairs. However, the community's declaration limits the HOA's insurance deductible to no more than \$10,000. Homeowners say the HOA violated its own rules by approving the new high-deductible insurance policy without considering cheaper alternatives or notifying them.


