2.2 Tie Cable ordering Limits

2.2.1 Combined Initial Order.

The number of Tie-Cables that must be ordered within the Combined Initial Order is fixed at 4×100 -pair (B cable).

2.2.2 Orders for Additional Tie-Cables

Orders for additional Tie-Cables can only be accepted as a multiple of 1 x 100-pair Tie-Cables (with a maximum of 8 x 100-pair Tie-Cable), subject to the following constraint:

The Service Taker is permitted to order additional Tie-Cables at the point in time at which the net amount of available connections on the Service

Taker's total number of Tie-Cables provisioned within a single Collocation Facility becomes 50% or less of the free available lines.
