



Quick Tips – Secure your Campsite for this year's event!

1. Plan ahead - Have a clear plan on which specific area within the Campground you are aiming to secure a site in (i.e. McPhillamy A)

- a. Review the FAQs on the website as this will help narrow down your selection
- b. How big is your set up? Review the approximate size of the campsites in the FAQs document. ALL of your camping set up (including vehicles) are to remain within your campsite markings. Vehicles parked outside your specific campsite markings will be removed.
- c. There are NO powered sites available at the B12 Hour
- d. Review the maps (also on the website) and have an understanding of the various sections within each campground.
 - i. The toilets are always marked "T"
 - ii. The toilet & shower blocks are marked "A"
 - iii. Each campground has showers and toilets - and all public sale campgrounds (except Reid & Sulman) use portable toilets and shower blocks
- e. If you require accessible amenities, please contact the camping team via camping@supercars.com.
- f. There is NO NEED to pre-register to access the site – just click on the links provided.
- g. If you have never been to Mount Panorama, viewing the area via [Google Maps](#) is extremely helpful. It shows where the various campgrounds are located in relation to each other.
- h. The maps do not show if sites are on a slight (or major) angle or if there is a tree on the site and/or not suitable for caravans/motorhomes. Where possible, we have added specific notes into affected sites which will pop up during site selection. This is of relevance to the available sites in Reid & Sulman and McPhillamy Park.
- i. Review approximate site availability table (*to assist in your planning, we have listed the number of sites available in each area of the Campgrounds*)

2. Be online at 12midday Wednesday!

- a. We recommend using a PC / laptop and not a mobile device
- b. Click on the link which will be visible on our website

- c. Do not change the dates of the booking!
 - i. It is the same site fee whether you are arriving on the Wednesday morning or the Friday afternoon. Changing the dates will delay your booking process;
 - ii. The number of guests on the site booking is not important at this time. The rules state that the total allowed is up to eight (8) guests. Once again, if you change this, you are delaying getting to where you need to go which is the site selection.
- d. Choose the specific area you want to search for a site in – i.e. PADDOCK C
- e. You can then select a site from the map. This is where being on a PC/laptop is beneficial – you can make the map bigger.
- f. Available sites are shown as GREEN DOTS – make your site selection and go through to complete your guest details and complete payment via credit / debit card (no afterpay is available).
- g. Once payment has gone through, you will receive a booking confirmation from the Bathurst Camping team.

3. Booking Multiple Sites

- a. If you wish to purchase more than one campsite, we strongly recommend that you:
- b. Select and complete payment for your first campsite before attempting to secure additional sites.
- c. Have all members of your group online and ready to book at 12:00 pm, as available sites may sell quickly.
- d. Do not spend time adjusting guest numbers or other booking details during the purchase process. These can be updated later if required.
- e. The Camping Team can assist with combining or amending bookings after the sale if sites have been purchased separately by members of the same group.
- f. If booking multiple sites in the same transaction, follow the prompts within the booking system to add additional sites before proceeding to payment.

4. A few other tips

- a. The camping team will be available to amend bookings in the 24 hours after the sale. So, if you end up with too many sites, or you have made an error along the way, please email us straight away (camping@supercars.com) and we should be able to assist.
- b. Unfortunately, demand for campsites will exceed the number of sites available and some fans will miss out. We will provide an update later in the week on the best place to secure a site for one year only should a camper not be able to attend.
