Drivalia's collaboration with **Pinacoteca Agnelli** continues in the spirit of environmental sustainability. Strike will open to the public from **Wednesday, March 8, to Sunday, July 23,** at the Pinacoteca. The exhibition is consistent with the institution's renewed contemporary mission to bring to light previously unseen artistic perspectives in relation to the historical and symbolic legacy of the exhibition venue and its industrial past.
