



Drivalia launches CarCloud Next Tonale, the Alfa Romeo C-SUV subscription

- Starting from 8 February, the mild hybrid version of the Alfa Romeo C-SUV will be included in CarCloud, the car subscription renewable for up to 12 months with over 30,000 users.
- Activatable on Amazon or at Drivalia Mobility Stores, the plan makes it possible to book a Tonale, pick it up and change it with a 48 business-hour notice.
- Available to private individuals and freelance professionals, the package also comprises a year's electric car sharing e-GO! Drivalia, with 60 minutes per month included.

Drivalia's mobility of the future adopts the quality and innovation of Auto Europa 2023¹. The company of the **FCA Bank Group** launches **CarCloud Next Tonale**, the subscription plan dedicated to **Alfa Romeo Tonale**, the first compact and electrified C-SUV of the Italian carmaker.

Starting from 8 February 2023, the Alfa Romeo model, in a mild hybrid version, will further enrich the plans of CarCloud, the car subscription chosen by **over 30,000 users** and available in four countries (Italy, France, Spain and Portugal). All customers need to do is to purchase a **voucher** - for €249, conveniently on **Amazon** or at **Drivalia Mobility Stores** - and then convert it on the CarCloud website.

Thus, they will be able to drive the C-SUV in the **Sprint** version, with its sportier connotation, and the **Ti** version, more elegant and stylish, on a subscription basis for €699 per month. The new Next Tonale will also be featured on the **new Brand store** created by Drivalia on Amazon (amazon.it/drivalia): a full catalogue of mobility plans offered on the platform.

The plan, which can be activated by private individuals and freelance professionals, can be **renewed monthly** for up to a maximum of one year, with a minimum duration of 30 days, after which it can be cancelled **without penalty**. Once the subscription has been activated, it will be possible to book the vehicle, pick it up and change it **with a 48 business-hour notice** at one of the participating Drivalia Mobility Stores.

Initially available in Rome, Milan, Turin, Bologna, Florence and Venice, Carcloud Next Tonale also comprises one year of **e-GO Drivalia electric car sharing**, with 60 minutes per month included.
