



# Top tips for Security Personnel

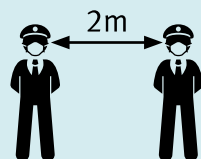
The security workforce is at the forefront of supporting the public to adjust to life post lockdown and the latest COVID-19 safety measures.

The following suggestions align with Government Guidance, the Centre for Protection of National Infrastructure (CPNI) campaign on 'COVID-19 Workplace Actions' and Security Industry Authority guidelines.

## Keep your distance

Remember to maintain a physical distance of two metres wherever possible. You're not being rude just keeping yourself and others safe.

## Wash your hands and keep your equipment clean

Regular hand washing is the most important thing you can do to stay safe. Maintain your hygiene, wash your hands regularly. Disinfect your radio and other equipment on a regular basis and every time contact with another person has been unavoidable.

## Communication is important

Talk to people, help them to understand that measures are in place for their safety. Use communication to de-escalate any confrontation.

## Know the plans

Be familiar with your company policy and Risk Assessments for COVID-19 safety. The way you are expected do your job might have changed. If you are in doubt, ask.

## Wear appropriate PPE

PPE protects the user against health or safety risks at work. Wearing a face covering is advised to help keep you and others around you safe. Follow the Government guidance.

## Support each other

Where you have new team members or temporary security colleagues, help them to understand the measures in place to keep them safe.
