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**Management discussion of fund performance**

**Results from Operations*****Investment performance***

For the six-month period ended June 30, 2026, EdgePoint Canadian Growth & Income Portfolio, Series A increased 4.0% versus an increase of 7.6% for its benchmark, the 60% S&P/TSX Composite Index / 40% ICE BofA Canada Broad Market Index. The S&P/TSX Composite Index increased by 11.2%, while the ICE BofA Canada Broad Market Index increased 2.2%. We manage the Fund independently of the indexes we use as long-term performance comparisons. Differences including security holdings, geographic/sector allocations and the relative weighting between equity and fixed-income investments may impact comparability and could result in periods when our performance differs materially from the index.

During the period, the Fund's underperformance relative to the Index was primarily attributable to portfolio positioning within the Financials sector. The Fund maintained an underweight allocation to Financials relative to the Index, a sector that outperformed the broader market during the period. In particular, the Fund did not hold the major Canadian banks, which generated strong returns and contributed meaningfully to the sector's performance. In addition, the fixed income securities within the Fund underperformed the ICE BofA Canada Broad Market Index over the period and had a negative impact on relative performance.

This was partially offset by positive contributions from the Information Technology sector. BlackBerry Ltd. generated a total return of 246% (in C\$), and the Fund's overweight position relative to the Index contributed positively to performance.

The blended benchmark provides a more appropriate comparison in view of the Fund's investment strategy and asset mix. The S&P/TSX Composite Index is a broad-based benchmark for Canadian equities. The ICE BofA Canada Broad Market Index tracks the performance of publicly traded investment-grade debt denominated in Canadian dollars and issued in the Canadian domestic market.

Meaningful contributors to investment results included:

- BlackBerry Ltd. 3.0%, due 2029/02/15
- Blackberry Ltd.
- CES Energy Solutions Corp.

As a group, these companies contributed approximately 3.5% to overall performance.

Meaningful detractors from investment results included:

- Topicus.com, Inc.
- Fairfax Financial Holdings Ltd.
- Constellation Software Inc.

As a group, these companies detracted approximately 1.9% from overall performance.

While we provide these results to fulfill the disclosure requirements of this report, we measure investment success over periods of 10 years or more and believe it takes considerable skill to consistently add value over the long term. We don't believe any meaningful conclusions can be drawn based on such a short period.

***Portfolio transactions***

During the period, the Fund net purchased \$212.3 million worth of investments. Portfolio turnover was 17.9% for the six months ended June 30, 2026 compared to 37.2% for the year ended December 31, 2025.

***Businesses purchased***

Examples of companies added to the Fund include:

- FirstService Corp. - Provider of essential property services
- S&P Global Inc. - Financial information service provider
- TerraVest Industries Limited - Specialized industrial equipment manufacturer

***Businesses sold***

We generally sell a stake in a business for one of two reasons. First, if our thesis about the business is deemed no longer valid. Second, there is a constant culling process whereby we continuously strive to upgrade the quality of the Fund with better ideas.

During the six-month period, examples of businesses sold include:

- Boardwalk REIT
- Applied Materials Inc.
- Koninklijke Philips N.V.

***Portfolio composition******Sector exposure***

Overall sector exposure shifted primarily as a result of investment decisions and changes in security prices. The most significant change was an increase of approximately 1.8% in the Fund's Industrials sector investments and a decrease of 2.0% in the Information Technology sector investments. The increase in the Fund's Industrials exposure was mainly due to the increased position in RB Global, Inc. Additionally, the decrease in the Fund's Information Technology exposure was primarily from a price decline in Constellation Software Inc. and Topicus.com, Inc.

### *Asset mix*

As at June 30, 2026, the Fund had a 38.3% investment in fixed-income securities and cash, a slight decrease from 38.5% on December 31, 2025. The balance of the Fund's assets consisted of equity securities. The Fund's cash position decreased from 18.8% at the end of 2025 to 7.9% as at June 30, 2026.

Portfolio transactions are a result of our "bottom-up" stock selection process. We don't construct the Fund with an index or benchmark in mind. As a result, the Fund's composition is typically very different from its benchmark index.

### *Fixed-income component*

We remain primarily invested in corporate fixed-income holdings, as we believe the risk-return potential for corporates is more attractive than government debt.

### *Income, fees and expenses*

The management expense ratio ("MER") has not changed significantly for all series of units of the Fund. We continue to focus on maintaining low operating expenses. Our goal as it relates to MERs has always been to be among the lowest-cost active managers in our distribution channel. Please refer to the Financial highlights section for more information about MERs for all series of units.

The overall changes to income, operating expenses, and net assets attributable to unitholders of redeemable units over the prior period is a result of change in Fund size and the overall composition of businesses in the Fund.

### *Unitholder activity*

During the period ended June 30, 2026, the Fund's net assets attributable to unitholders of redeemable units ("NAV") increased to \$3.7 billion from \$3.5 billion as at December 31, 2025. Of this increase, \$154.9 million is a gain attributed to operations and \$34.8 million in net inflows to the Fund.

### *Recent developments*

Canadian equity markets advanced during the period, although returns were driven by a relatively narrow group of businesses. Strong performance from the Energy sector and Canada's largest financial institutions accounted for a significant portion of the market's gains, while developments surrounding artificial intelligence led investors to reassess the long-term outlook for parts of the Information Technology sector, particularly software businesses. We believe periods like these can create compelling opportunities for active investors willing to look beyond prevailing market narratives, and focus instead on the long-term value of individual businesses.

Rather than attempting to predict the direction of markets or position the Fund based on macroeconomic forecasts, we continue to focus on identifying individual businesses where long-term earnings growth and business quality are not fully reflected in current share prices. Periods of heightened market dispersion can create opportunities to upgrade the quality of ideas, businesses, management teams and growth characteristics within the Fund. We remain focused on owning

high-quality Canadian businesses that we believe can create value for investors over the long term.

Credit spreads remained near historically tight levels during the period, reducing the incremental compensation available for taking on additional credit risk. While tighter spreads have reduced the opportunity set, we continue to find overlooked securities that we believe offer attractive yields without compromising our underwriting standards. Rather than stretching for yield, we remain focused on what we can control: the quality of the credit. We continue to believe the best opportunities come from better understanding businesses and investing only when we are appropriately compensated for the risks we are taking.

### *Related parties*

### *Manager*

The Fund is managed by EdgePoint Wealth Management Inc. ("EdgePoint"). As Manager, EdgePoint provides (or arranges for) investment management, distribution, marketing and promotion of the Fund. As compensation for providing these services, EdgePoint receives a monthly management fee based on the daily average NAV of each series of the Fund (see Management fees).

EdgePoint is also responsible for the Fund's day-to-day operation. EdgePoint will often incur, on behalf of the Fund, costs associated with the Fund's operations including, but not limited to, legal fees, custodian and safekeeping fees, audit fees, administrative and operating costs, including commissions, brokerage fees, trustee fees, taxes, registrar and transfer agency fees, unitholder servicing costs, the costs of preparing and distributing annual and semi-annual reports, prospectuses, statements and investor communications, regulatory filing fees, fees and expenses payable in connection with the Independent Review Committee ("IRC"), interest and other general operating expenses that could include allocated salaries, overhead and other costs directly related to the Fund's operations. These services are in the normal course of operations and are charged at the rate agreed to by the parties. EdgePoint is entitled to be reimbursed by the Fund for these operating costs.

The management fees payable by Series I unitholders are negotiated and paid directly by them. Operating expenses for Series I unitholders are EdgePoint's responsibility and are not charged to the Fund.

### *Investment Advisor*

EdgePoint Investment Group Inc. ("Investment Advisor") is the Fund's portfolio advisor. The Investment Advisor is entitled to be reimbursed by EdgePoint for certain operating expenses associated with its advisory services, which are paid by EdgePoint with the fees received as Manager. The Fund is not separately charged for the services of the Investment Advisor.

### *Independent Review Committee*

EdgePoint has appointed an Independent Review Committee ("IRC") consisting of three independent members and established under the Canadian Securities Administrators' National Instrument 81-107. The

IRC's mandate is to review and provide input on EdgePoint's written policies and procedures that pertain to conflict of interest matters with respect to EdgePoint-managed funds, including EdgePoint affiliates. Additional information about the IRC is available in the Simplified Prospectus and Annual Information Form for the Fund. IRC members receive fees and reimbursement of expenses for services provided to the Fund.

- The trading expense ratio represents total commissions and other portfolio transaction costs expressed as an annualized percentage of the Fund's daily average NAV. The trading expense ratio is calculated at the fund level and applies to all series of the Fund. The ratio for June 30, 2026 is annualized.
- Portfolio turnover rate is calculated at the fund level based on the lesser of purchases or proceeds of sales of securities for the period, excluding cash, short term notes and bonds having maturity dates at acquisition of one year or less, divided by the average value of the portfolio securities for the period. The Fund's portfolio turnover rate indicates how actively the Fund's portfolio advisor manages its portfolio investments. A portfolio turnover rate of 100% is equivalent to the Fund buying and selling all of the securities in its portfolio once in the course of the period. The higher a fund's portfolio turnover rate in a period, the greater the trading costs payable by the fund in the period, and the greater the chance of an investor receiving taxable capital gains in the period. There is not necessarily a relationship between a high turnover rate and fund performance.

## Management fees

As compensation for the services provided, EdgePoint, the Manager of the Fund, receives a monthly management fee based on the daily average NAV of Series A, Series A(N), Series AT4, Series A(N)T4, Series F, Series F(N), Series FT4, and Series F(N)T4. Management fees for Series I are negotiated and paid directly by unitholders and not by the Fund.

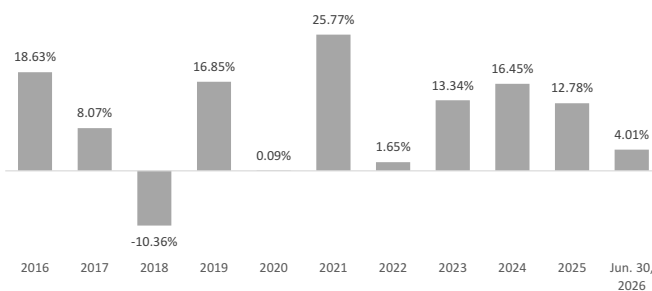
## Past performance

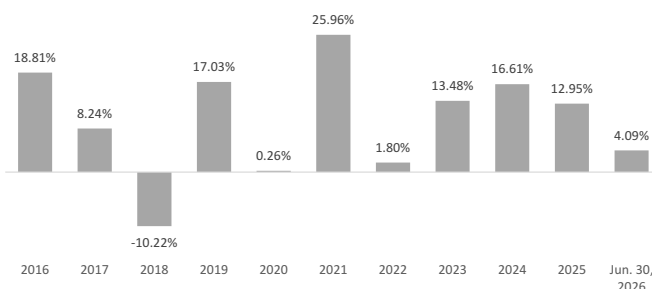
### Year-by-year returns

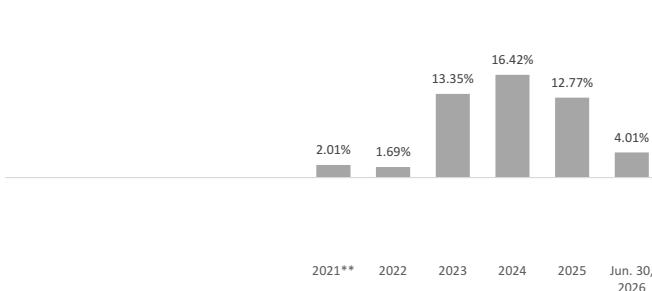

Series A(N) Non-HST

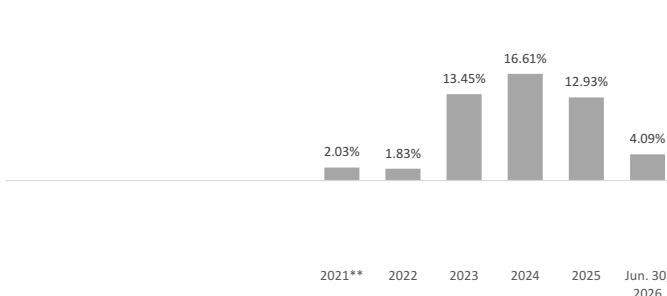


Series AT4

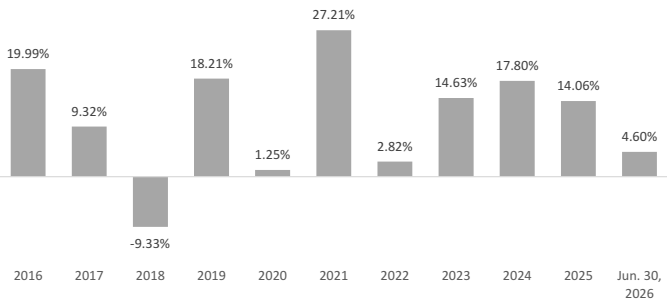

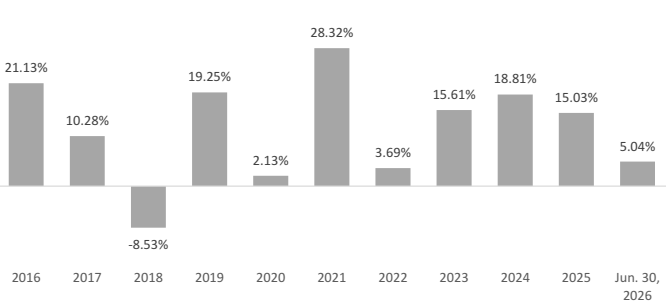

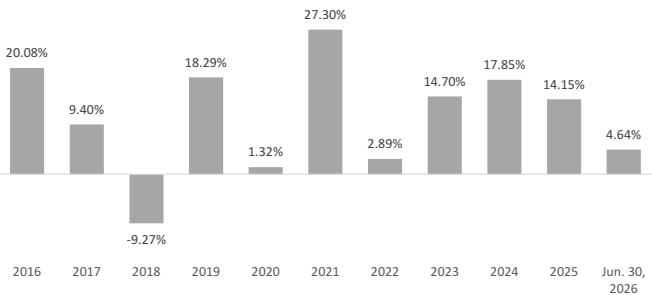

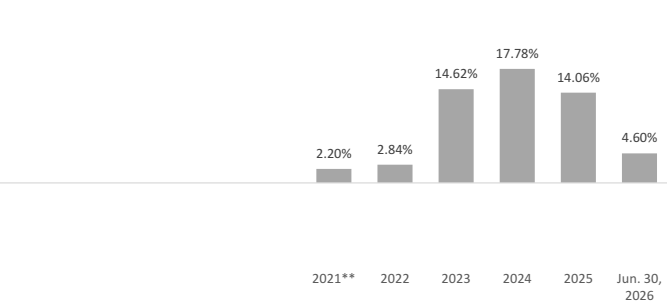

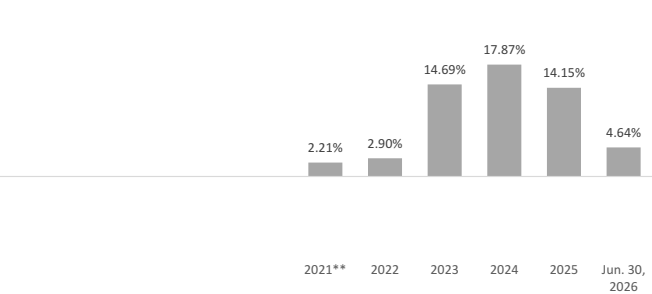
