

Deployment governance



 Four main instruments for harnessing structural interaction:

DM instruments to connect with stakeholders

- Cooperative arrangements
- Consultation platform
- > Advisory Board
- Liaison Officers





Cooperative Arrangements

- Mandatory cooperative arrangements : SJU, NSA, Military / EDA, Network Manager and Manufacturing industry,
- Cooperative arrangements on a voluntary basis : EASA, Eurocontrol, Standardisation bodies, EUMETNET, professional staff associations ...
- Generic draft cooperative arrangement in preparation
- Coming months : contact with envisaged interfaces to discuss and conclude cooperative arrangements



Stakeholders' Consultation Platform

- For all operational investors like ANSP's, Airport Operators, Airlines, Network Manager, Meteo providers, ...
- Initial Terms of Reference, to be fine tuned
- Consists of different working groups, depending on the subject (DP, CBA, CP, ...)
- Aimed at buy-in internally at DM level for the Deployment Plan
- Does not replace the formal consultation procedure organised by the EC and potential endorsement for new Common Projects.



Advisory Board

A support to the Supervisory Board

Participants:

- Stakeholders assisting EC in the Policy Level
- > 1 representative per stakeholders' group.
- The Advisory Board will meet at least once a year, if possible twice, for the following years.



Liaison Officers concept

Aim : connect with all stakeholders through trusted channels – talk to someone you know or is in the same business.

Establish long term relationship to take the views of the investors on board in the broader DM work

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

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Introduction to the **Preliminary Deployment** Programme (PDP V0)

From ATM Master Plan (2012) to PDP V0



- The Preliminary Deployment Programme (PDP V0) provides the initial project view of the ATM functionalities of the Pilot Common Project in order to support the successful implementation of EC Regulation (EU) N°716/2014.




Preliminary Deployment Programme (PDP)

The PDP is intended to:

- Speed up and complete deployment of all the pre-requisites and facilitators of the PCP functionalities, in order to be ready for a timely, coordinated and synchronised deployment of PCP elements;
- Start the deployment of mature elements of the PCP.


PDP V0 focuses on "Fast Tracks", i.e. families Implementation Projects mature for deployment.







AF1 - Fast tracks



Extended Arrival management (AMAN) and Performance Based Navigation (PBN) in high density Terminal Maneuvering Areas (TMAs) improves the precision of the approach trajectory and facilitates air traffic sequencing at an earlier stage.





INEA Call 2014 A joint effort by the Deployment Manager and the candidate Implementing Partners

A specific environment

Key parameters

- Launched on 11 September 2014, deadline 26 February 2015
- 300M€ of co-funding, 80% for "PCP related" Implementation Projects
- In accordance with EC's set-up for SESAR deployment, implementation projects "PCP related" will be awarded within a Framework Partnership Agreement (FPA)
 - Implementing partners of a (cluster of) selected project not in the FPA yet, will be required to join the FPA and sign the Internal Cooperation Agreement
 - Deployment Manager being the coordinator of this FPA, it is also the Action Coordinator for every (cluster of) selected project





From INEA call to invitation letter

INEA Call published on 11 September 2014 – Funding Objective 3 addresses «SESAR Deployment» through the implementation of the Pilot Common Project (PCP)

> DFS, ENAV and SDAG (SESAR related Deployment Airport Operators Grouping) took over the responsibility to lead coordinated proposals

> > On 28 November DFS, ENAV and SDAG invited stakeholders to join in the preparation of common proposals on the basis of the implementation prerequisites and facilitators, identified by IDSG in the Interim Transition Report

Following the publication of the Preliminary Deployment Programme on 5 December, the PDP is now the reference to ensure the alignment of the implementing projects to be submitted to INEA call

Accordingly, to better coordinate the proposals in terms of bid preparation it is proposed a CLUSTER APPROACH





Cluster approach

Preparing for synchronised and coordinated implementation

- "Cluster approach" is an ad-hoc working structure to integrate individual/local proposals for PCP related Implementation Projects into 3 "Master proposals" in accordance with the AF they address
 - Cluster 1: TMA and Ground/Ground Communication: FTs for AF1 and AF5
 - Cluster 2: Airports integration and throughput: FTs for AF2
 - Cluster 3: En Route and FDP upgrades: FTs for AF3, AF4 and AF6


□ If successful, "Cluster approach" would result into:

- > 3 Specific Grant Agreements instead of several tens
- > Reduced administrative burden for the implementing partners
- Improved DM support to the implementing partners





Clusters preparation structure





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DM role towards Level 3

The DM is responsible for*:

- (a) developing, proposing, maintaining and implementing the deployment programme;
- (b) associating the operational stakeholders that are required to implement common projects;

* Regulation EU N°409/2013

Accordingly, from 12/01/15 to 28/01/15 the DM will assess the Implementation Projects initiatives submitted, and potentially propose fine-tuning actions using PCP and PDP V0 as references, in order to:

- 1. Ensure consistency of the Implementation Projects
- 2. Analyse the gaps in terms of missing application stakeholders
- 3. Analyse the gaps in terms of timescale of the proposed Implementation Projects
- 4. Check geographical applicability
- 5. Provide support to stakeholders



Short term roadmap (1/3)

Call's timeline

- On going discussion with EC to postpone the deadline by at least one month in order to:
 - Provide stakeholders with more time to familiarise with PDP and the cluster approach
 - Provide DM with the minimum time required to successfully organise applications to the call










Preliminary organisation of the Deployment Manager






