

2025 Calgary Stampede Princess Contest

Horsemanship Competence Statement

The Stampede Princess Contest, and ultimately the internship for the successful contestant, is designed to assess the skills of the contestants and then further develop these skill sets in numerous areas, including horsemanship (riding ability, safety, animal care, teamwork and willingness to learn).

During their reign, the Stampede Princess will attend events both with and without the Stampede Royalty horses. Safety is the top priority of the Calgary Stampede when working with and around animals. The Stampede Princess will attend parades, rodeos (which may include grand entry), round-ups, trail rides and so forth. They will be in arenas with many other animals, fireworks, loud noises, commentators, 30,000 cheering guests, children, and people, in many different locations, and in many different environments. They will be riding the Stampede Royalty horses at all Stampede events, which may act differently than horses the contestants are used to.

While the Stampede Princess will receive training, we require the contestants entering the contest to have a certain level of skill and to demonstrate an ability to handle the horses in a safe manner at all times. This means they need to be able to react and maintain control over their horse as proficiently as possible to ensure the safety of all. Accordingly, this Horsemanship Competence Statement is the first step in helping to assess the existing skill set of the contestants and ensuring a great, safe experience for all.

We require each contestant and a bona fide equestrian trainer to attest to the following statements pertaining to horsemanship and riding ability.
